

Graduation Requirements

In accordance with Pennsylvania State Requirements, Keystone National High School requires twenty-one (21) credits for graduation. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania also stipulates the distribution of these credits as follows:

- Four (4) English credits
- Four (4) Social Studies credits
- Three (3) Math credits (must include at least one credit of Algebra I or higher)
- Three (3) Science credits
- One (1) Health credit
- One (1) Fine Arts (Humanities) credit
- Five (5) Elective credits

Graduation Policies

- Students must earn **at least 5 full-credits** from Keystone in order to receive a Keystone National High School Diploma.
- Students must complete one course in each of the major subject (core) areas regardless of the number of transfer credits in that area.
 - English
 - Math
 - Science
 - Social Studies
 - One credit in a subject of choice (elective)
- Any course/credit taken above our required number credits will count as an elective.
- Student must be actively enrolled in The Keystone School at the time of high school completion in order to earn a Keystone diploma.
- A final diploma and official transcript will be issued once students have met the requirements set out in all KNHS policies.
- Keystone reserves the right to review, rescind, and/or hold a KNHS diploma when it is determined necessary to preserve the academic integrity of The Keystone School.
